In both instances we have had positive parental involvement. We cannot express enough how much we value the continued commitment parents make when we venture out beyond the school environment. Next week our Year 5 and 6 class head to Omokoroa for their camp which will also have a strong aquatic focus. Living as we do surrounded by ocean it is vital that we provide all our students with a strong sense of how we need to take personal responsibility around our waterways, but equally help develop the skills and confidence they need to be safe in and around the water.

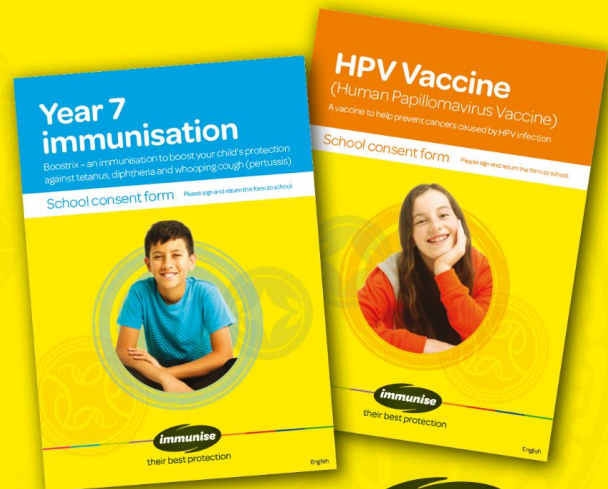
