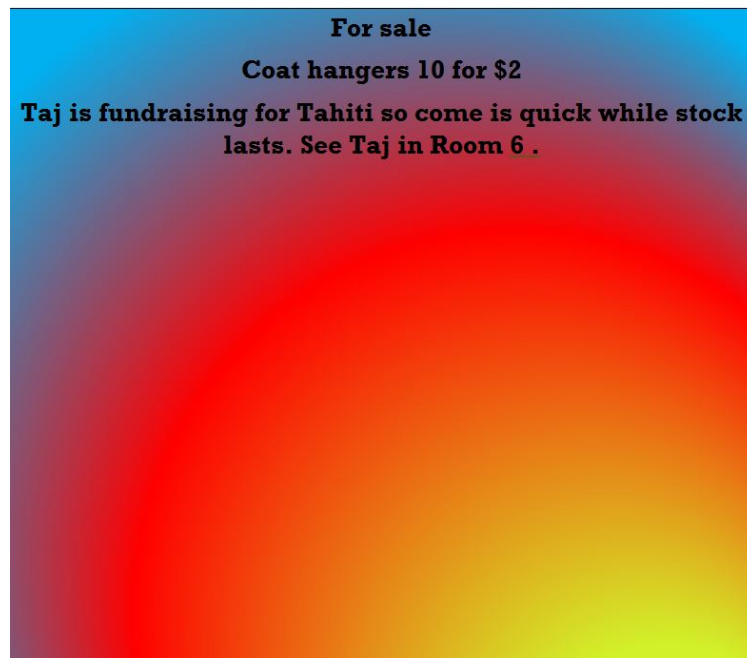
SCHOOL WIDE – MISCELLANEOUS

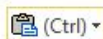
St Paul's Collegiate School, Hamilton
